Supplies needed:

- 8x12 cardboard or matboard sheet
- Hot glue, glue stick, or Elmer’s glue
- Aluminum foil and aluminum foil tape
- Paper clips
- Beads, rice, buttons, etc. (small decorative objects)
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Writing and coloring utensils (pens, colored pencils, crayons, etc.)

Supplies needed:

For the stop motion animation:

- Variety of colored and white paper
- Scissors
- Sticky tack or glue dots
- Small found objects (buttons, beads, etc.)
- Writing and coloring utensils (pens, colored pencils, crayons, etc.)
- Phone or tablet
- Small desk lamp or light
- Animation stand

For the stop motion animation stand:

1. Take a medium-sized cardboard box (paper ream boxes work well)
2. Place the box on its side and cut a small hole on the top
3. Place a small desk lamp or other light inside the box
4. Download “Stop Motion Studio” app on your phone or tablet
